

Calculating Road Ban limit

The front steering axle for most trucks is 5500 kg's. When a road ban is 350 it means the limit on the vehicle weight is based on 350 lbs per square inch of tire.

To calculate Count the #of tires on a vehicle and multiply it by the width of each tire. Most tires 11 inches. This will give you the number of pounds you can carry.

of tires on truck x tire width = load limit

Calculate the trailer separate from the truck and don't count the front two tires.
