TORNADO SAFETY

Know the signs of a tornado:

- Severe thunderstorms with frequent thunder and lightning
- An extremely dark sky, sometimes highlighted by green or yellow clouds
- A rumbling sound, such as a freight train or a whistling sound similar to a jet aircraft
- A funnel cloud at the rear of a thunder cloud often behind a curtain of heavy rain or hail

WHAT TO DO...

In A Building:

- Go to the basement or take shelter in a small interior ground room floor such as a bathroom, closet or hallway...avoid windows, outside walls and doors
- Protect yourself by getting into a "crouch position-face down-hands above head" under a heavy table or desk.
- Cover yourself with a mattress, sleeping bag, etc. to protect from falling debris in the event the roof or ceiling fails
- Do NOT use elevators
- Avoid gymnasiums, halls, churches, arenas etc. as their roofs are more likely to collapse.

Mobile home/recreation vehicle:

- If time allows find shelter elsewhere, preferably in a building with a strong foundation
- If no shelter is available, get into the "crouch position" in a ditch away from the mobile home or recreation vehicle. Beware of flooding from downpours and be prepared to move

In a Vehicle:

- If you spot a tornado in the <u>distance</u>, go to the nearest solid shelter
- If the tornado is close, get out of your vehicle and take cover in a low-lying area, such as a ditch.
 DO NOT take shelter under an overpass or bridge. Winds can accelerate in these areas
- If you are caught by extreme winds/flying debris and unable to leave the vehicle;
 - Park vehicle quickly and safely out of traffic lanes ... SEATBELT ON
 - > Put your head below the windows; and cover with jacket, blanket, etc for protection

AFTER THE TORNADO...

Keep your family together! Remain <u>CALM and ALERT</u>...listen for information and instructions from emergency crew and local officials. Be aware of possible downed power lines, broken glass & sharp objects. Stay out of damaged houses/buildings and avoid using matches or lighters in case of leaking natural gas lines, etc.
