In the fall of 2018, Jim Doud, Laura Lee Marin-Petersen, and Alan Krausher were acclaimed Councillors of Divisions 2, 4 and 6, respectively. Rick Ricard will continue to serve his term as the Councillor of Division 4 until "Election Day" for rural municipalities: October 24, 2018. Laura Lee Marin-Petersen will commence her term as Councillor of Division 4 by the next meeting of Council, which is scheduled for November 6, 2018. The election for offices of Reeve and Councillors of Division 1, 3, and 5 will take place in the fall of 2020.

Project Status Updates

- Council has passed a revised Council Procedures Bylaw, Asset Management Policy, and Asset Management Strategy.
- Administration has started working on an Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw update.
- Public Works has rebuilt Township Road 40 from range road 160 to 170.
- Plans are in place to work with contractors to realign Range Road 171 adjacent to SW 1-4-17 W2M.
- The attic of the municipal office building was insulated.
- A water tank and pump were purchased for use in the application of dust control and to offload water into the fire truck, if required.
- The municipality intends to purchase a water pump and piping to rent out to the public for agricultural use.
- Gravel crushing has commenced to increase the municipalities gravel inventory for use in upcoming years.
- Regular operations within the municipality continue throughout the year including: grading roads, mowing ditches, removing snow, and controlling pests, just to name a few.
