### Utility Billing Rate Changes

Effective January 1, 2019 an increase will be made to the water, sewer and infrastructure rates.

Quarterly rates will be as follows:

Water \$75.00/6000 gallons

(Minimum Usage over 6000 gallons is charged \$ .75/100 gallons)

Sewer (flat rate)  
\$45.00

Waste/Recycling (flat rate)  
\$62.50

Water Infrastructure (flat rate)  
\$30.00

Sewer Infrastructure (flat rate)  
\$30.00

---

Minimum quarterly rate \$242.50

This is based on residential rates as different rates apply to commercial properties.

Non-meters Mobile Home Rates:

Water \$90 flat rate

Sewer (flat rate)  
\$45.00

Waste/Recycling (flat rate)  
\$62.50

Water Infrastructure (flat rate)  
\$30.00

Sewer Infrastructure (flat rate)  
\$30.00

## Dog/Cat Licenses

Any resident who owns a dog/cat within Town limits must register their pets with the Town Office.

Licenses are due January 1st of each year; the fee is \$20 for each dog/cat.

Restricted dog license fees are \$250.00 per dog. For a list of restricted dogs please refer to Bylaw No. 2016-15.

Pets shall wear a collar and the tag is to be attached to the collar. The purpose of registration is to have a record of dogs/cats in Town, which allows us to contact owners in situations where necessary.

No person shall possess more than 2 dogs or 2 cats per dwelling unit.

## Waste Management Area

### Winter Hours

November 2018—March 2019

Wednesday 1:00 p.m.—3:00 p.m.

Saturday 11:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m.

All loads taken to the waste management area need to be tarped and/or secured to prevent the loss of debris.

Violators will be fined.

The Town waste management area is located 2 miles south, 2 miles east and 1/2 mile north of Radville.

A compost site is located south of Town on Toronczuk Avenue, east of E. Bourassa and Sons.

Any compost material such as garden waste, leaves, grass clippings and fruits and vegetables are accepted.

Branches, trees or household waste is not accepted at the compost site and must be taken to the waste management area.



## Snow Removal

The Town of Radville is reminding residents that when it snows, please do not push or pile snow on the street. The Town will not send out a grader or tractor to remove snow on streets that have already been cleaned. Please be mindful that when snow mounds build up it can cause visibility restraints for drivers. Following a snowfall please move vehicles parked on the street. This will assist the Town staff to be able to clear streets in a timely and effective manner.

## Reminder

Please refrain from disposing of oil or greasy products through the sewer system. The Town of Radville is asking your assistance to not pour any type of cooking oil or grease down the drain and into the sewer line. These products need to be disposed of into the garbage. When the sewer line plugs it can cause back up of the sewer into houses, but also costs the Town thousands of dollars to rectify.
