*"That all custom work requests must be made at the municipal office, on the municipality's Custom/Contract Work Form, which must be read and signed by the Contracting Party, the division Councillor, and the Administrator; and further that the Municipality will not perform any ditching, trenching, or diking."*

**Cemetery Fees:**

- \$100 for plots in new cemetery. No plots are sold in old cemetery. At time of burial there is \$150.00 burial site fee. All are subject to GST (PST exempt).
- \$50 scattering garden registration fee. Subject to GST (PST exempt).
- Columbarium niches are \$550.00 + GST (PST exempt). Columbarium plaques have an estimated cost of \$400.00 per full bronze plaque, \$40.00 for additional date of death plaque; GST and shipping added.

**Other Fees:**

- Zoning Bylaw controls proximities. \$10.00 Development fee for development permits. \$450.00 drilling license fee for oil well site drilling per downhole.
- Gravel Excavation Fees as per Bylaw 1/2018 are:
  - a) 16.5 cents per cubic meter for each cubic meter; or
  - b) 12.6 cents per cubic yard for each cubic yard; or
  - c) 8.9 cents per tonne for each tonne; or
  - d) 8.2 cents per ton for each ton of gravel excavated from the premise.
- Road maintenance agreements are required for bulk hauls for gravel and oil. Please contact the municipal office prior to commencing haul.
- Overweight permit are for non-divisible loads over secondary weights and are issued on a daily basis only:
  - a) \$100 per truck and trailer unit per day (Non-Divisible Load Permit)
  - b) \$50.00 per truck and trailer unit per day (Divisible Agricultural Commodities Load Permit)
  - c) \$200.00 per truck and trailer unit per year (Divisible Agricultural Commodities Load Permit)
    - Must utilize shortest route directly to the 705 Primary Weight Corridor

**Fences:**

- **\*\*Fences are to be put up on the edge of the right-of-way (road allowance)**
- Where there is no road allowance – if the ratepayers can agree – on the line
- Where there is no road allowance – if the ratepayers cannot agree – on own property line
- Adjacent to crops fences must be 2.5 meters from crop. Lawful fences are defined in Section 18 of *The Stray Animals Act*.
