# Town Tidbits

## Friendly Reminders...

- ◆ When Town employees are busy cleaning the streets or doing any other work on the streets, please take precautions when passing the Town equipment. If you happen to see the crews working on the streets please find an alternate route until the work is complete. This would help to make their job a lot safer.
- ◆ Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 48 hours. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property.
- ◆ All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Radville Bylaw.
- ◆ ATV's are NOT for recreational use within Town limits.
- ◆ Any resident who owns a dog/cat within Town limits must register their pets with the Town Office. Licenses are due January 1st of each year; the fee is \$20 for each dog/cat, unless it is considered to be a restricted dog. Restricted dog license fees are \$250 per dog, please refer to Bylaw No. 2016-15 for a list of restricted dogs.
- ◆ Every person who, being in charge of a dog or cat, which defecates on public property or on any private property without the owner's permission and who fails to immediately collect, remove and dispose of such fecal matter is guilty of an infraction of Bylaw No. 2016-15. Please be kind to your neighbours and those walking the streets and pick up after your pet. Thank you...

- ◆ Taxes and utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking. Please contact the Town Office to obtain your account numbers. Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bill, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is received by our office before any penalties apply.
