

BYLAW NO. 10-97

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF RADVILLE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES .

The Council of the Town of Radville, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

[1] Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Subsection (1) of Section 21 of The Snowmobile Act, RRS, 1978, it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on all streets except:

- (1) Main Street between Railway Avenue and Crane Avenue,
- (2) Healy Avenue between Highway No. 28 and Highway No. 377,
- (3) Warren Street between Healy Avenue and Beckwell Avenue, and
- (4) Provincial Highways No. 28 and No. 377 within the limits of the Town of Radville,

except only for the purpose of crossing said Main Street, Healy Avenue, Warren Street and Provincial Highways No. 28 and No. 377.

[2] That Bylaw No. 1/74 is hereby repealed.
